Included is a typed page listing 1936 given By Florence (Corbin) Pardee to Marshall Graham Hill, through Walter Peck, son of "Reid" (Reed) Peck (early member of the Church)

Typed paper states Reid Peck (misprint from typist), and clamshell lists as Reed Peck.

Features and Notes:

Spine: Intact. slight wear at bottom and top edge. Gold lines visible.

Spine Lettering and Label: Black ribbon in place, All gold lettering visible

Cover: intact and attached. Noticeable wear on corners. Circular discoloration on lower half of front cover.

Binding: Intact, front end paper present. Darker stain front end paper lower half of page.

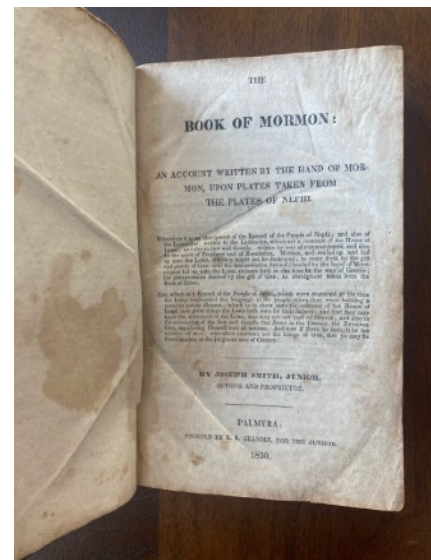
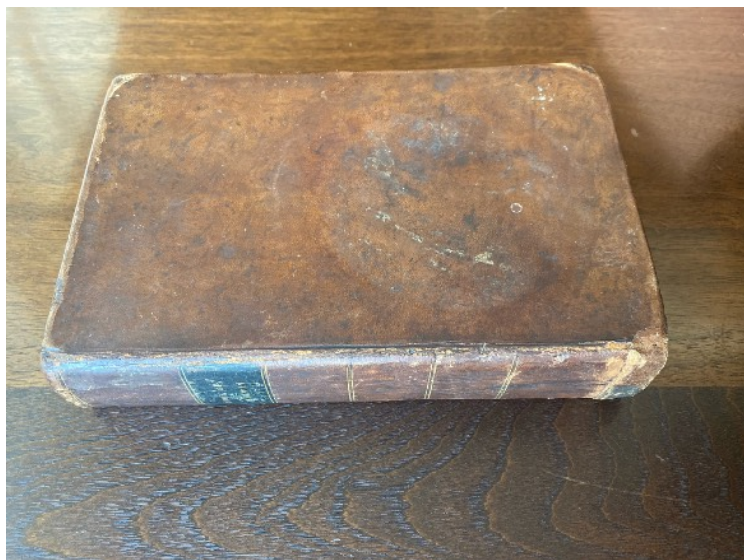

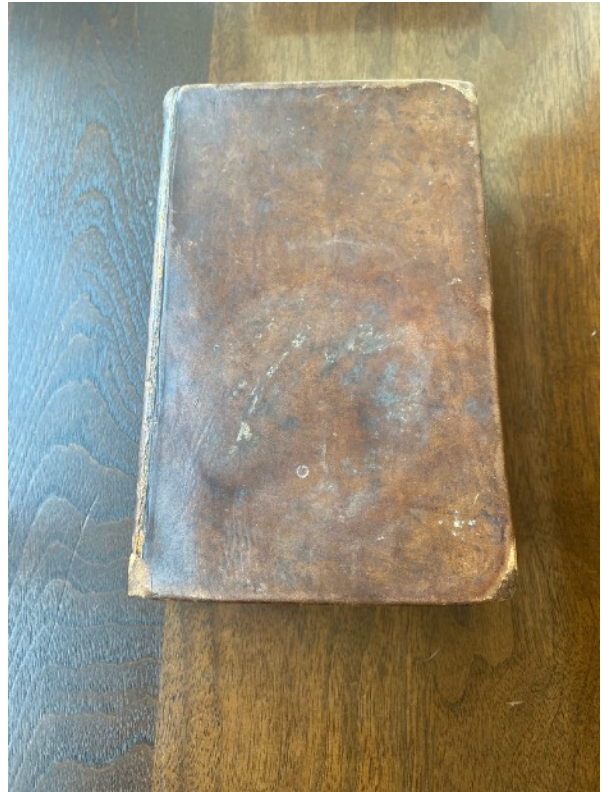
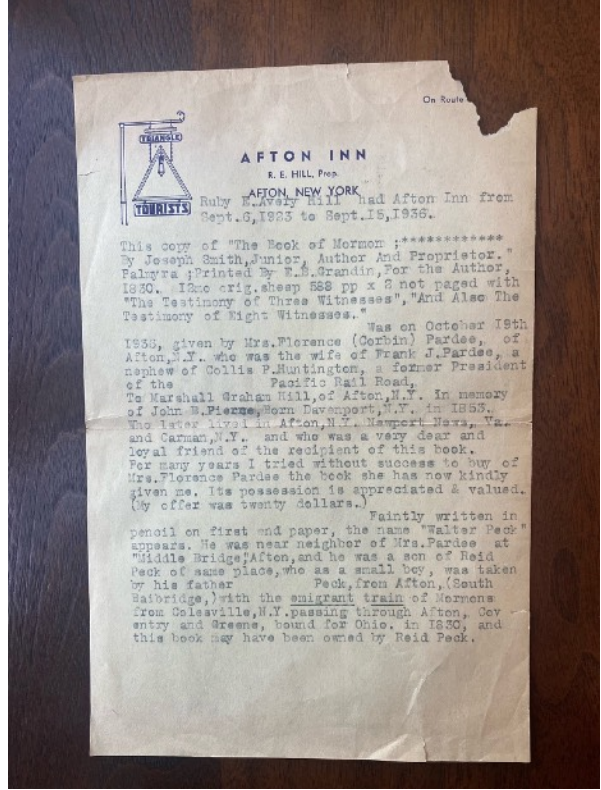
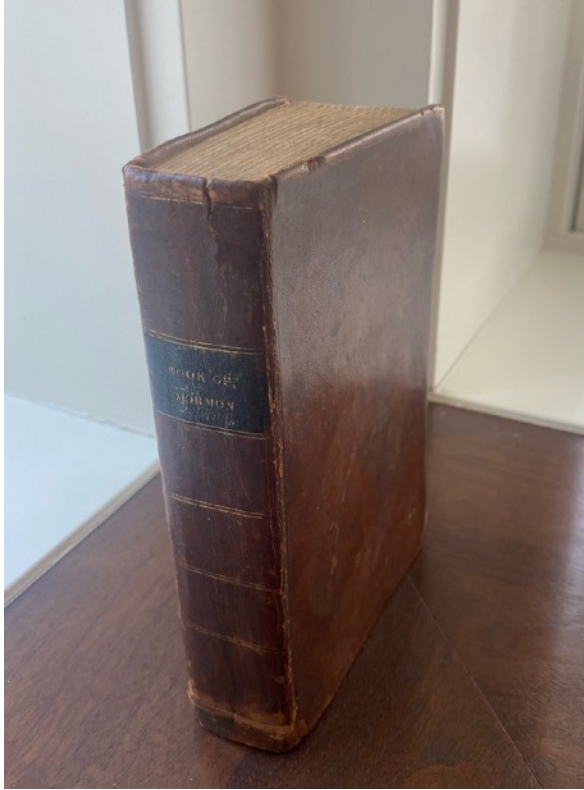
Text: Full set, intact
